Terms and Conditions of Sale

1. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the description of lots but we hereby give notice that all statements, whether spoken or written, are those of opinion only and we do not hold ourselves liable for any errors or omissions. Obvious defects will be noted and unless stated otherwise, all items are considered by us to be in at least good to very good condition. Customers are reminded that certain lots may be fragile due to their age, wear, etc. When handling such material on viewing day at Derby, you are asked to treat it with the utmost care and attention.
2. Carriage and packing will be charged extra at cost (subject to a minimum charge of £3). Items will be sent by Royal Mail. If requested on the bidding form, we will dispatch items by Special Delivery (with insurance up to £2,500) or Recorded Delivery (without compensation). It is also possible to insure items dispatched by Royal Mail Standard Parcels. All additional costs for these services will be passed on to the purchaser via the invoice. We always obtain a Certificate of Posting, but do not hold ourselves liable for loss or damage in transit once items have been handed over to Royal Mail.
3. Bids should be made on the Bidding Form (yellow) provided with the catalogue. The Bidding Form may also be downloaded from the website.
4. All lots in this section carry a reserve which is published and in all cases will be no less than a minimum of £5. Bids may be for any amount in whole pounds (pence will be ignored) and the highest bidder on any lot will be successful. The amount of the bid paid by the successful bidder, which will be at one bidding step above the previous highest bidder, will be determined by bid increments as defined in the following scale:

Routes to the Auction

The Gateway Centre is adjacent to the Derbyshire County Cricket Club ground and is located to the east of the city close to the A52 trunk road from Nottingham – Derby (10 minutes from M1 Junction 25).

1. **From M1 South:** take **J25** exit – **A52** Derby. After 6 miles, arrive at **Pentagon Island**. The ground is the 4th exit off this roundabout, signposted with a brown cricket sign.
2. **From M1 North:** take **J28** exit – **A38** Derby. After approx. 13 miles, arrive at a roundabout and take the 1st exit, **A61**, signposted with a brown cricket sign. Follow over two more roundabouts, staying on the A61. Just before the 3rd roundabout, **Pentagon Island**, take the left turn into the cricket ground. If you should miss it, take the 1st exit off the roundabout into the ground.
3. **From Birmingham:** travel up the **A38** to the A61 roundabout. Take the 2nd exit, **A61** Derby, signposted with a brown cricket sign. Follow over two more roundabouts, **Pentagon Island**, then take the left turn into the cricket ground. If you should miss it, take the 1st exit off the roundabout into the ground.
4. **From M6:** take **J15** exit and follow the signs to the **A50** (Uttoxeter). Follow the A50 for approx. 20 miles to the junction with the **A516** to Derby. Take the A516 until it joins the **A38**, then follow the directions (from Birmingham) above.
5. **From the Railway Station:** take a taxi, or else proceed by foot towards the town centre along **Siddalls Road**. Turn right at **The Cock Pitt** and continue into **St Edmunds Way**, cross the river, bear right and head towards **Pentagon Island**. The ground is 4th exit off this roundabout, signposted with a brown cricket sign.
